

2010 Southwest Oral History Association General Scholarship Opportunity:

Deadline: January 31, 2010

The Southwest Oral History Association will award two scholarships to deserving oral historians and practitioners to attend the annual conference which will be held in Boulder City, NV from April 9-11, 2010. Funding will include a cash award of \$300 for each recipient. These awards will be applied toward hotel and travel expenses along with conference registrations, Awards Luncheon and one workshop. Students, teachers, independent oral historians, and individuals associated with nonprofit organizations are encouraged to apply.

The application letter should include a statement of the applicant's financial need; an indication of the level of financial support, if any, that is offered by the applicant's institution or employer; and a paragraph explaining how the scholarship will advance the applicant's goals in the field of oral history. Include a resume and provide names and phone numbers of two professional or academic references.

The recipient will be expected to attend the entire conference and write a brief article highlighting some important experiences from the conference for possible publication in the SOHA newsletter.
